Arturo Ballester Molina Sums up his passion for photography. Born in Buenos Aires in August 2, 1957, r has dedicated his life to take pictures and teach photography, an activity that he embraces with absolute passion.

He trained with one of the most celebrated masters of photography in Argentina, Pedro Luis Raota, and after several years as a photojournalist he applied his knowledge and experience to the field of advertising photography. Years later when he saw the advance of technology he decided to study in New York and learned everything related to digital photography, specializing in one area that still surprises with its infinite possibilities.

Convened by Kodak Professional he performed in the country a number of seminars for photographers of the Pro Image. Arturo has been at the head of Photo Studio for 15 years a professional photography studio where the leading brands in the country entrust their visual needs. He has been working for four years with people of northern Argentina, offering help and registering the eyes of its people. His most recent works were included in a campaign that was published in the leading newspaper in Finland

In 2004 he exposes several presentations: In Darwine, with Photographs of "Mendoza" "Glaciers" in the lounges of Laboratory Andromaco and the show "Argentina in silence" in the space Argentina Eterna.

He has recently published "Coasts of Maldonado", "Coasts of Rocha", "Coasts of Colonia" and "Coast of wine" of the Collection Rumbos de and el calendario "Argentina 2006" of Granica Publications.

He currently is working in the production of his books "The route of wine" and "Glaciers". At the beginning of 2005 there were presentations of the books mentioned before at the Hotel Conrad of Punta del Este, Trench Gallery La Barra Pta. del Este y Argentino Hotel of Piriápolis.
